This integrative workshop will explore plant adaptation with a particular focus on molecular changes in an ecological context and the interaction between ecology and genomics. Speakers will address different hierarchical levels at which adaptation may be studied: population level (polymorphism within populations and species), species level (speciation and adaptive radiation) and supraspecific level (key innovations characteristic of major clades, evolution of body plans and major developmental genes).
